This program is designed to produce finance professionals with a solid foundation in modern finance theory who are capable of performing applied research. Courses in the program will emphasize quantitative financial analysis, investments and portfolio management, derivatives, corporate finance, capital budgeting, business valuation, financial markets, multinational finance, security valuation, investment banking, and alternative investments. The program includes 30 credits of coursework, a comprehensive exam, and is delivered online. Students without a prior background in business or finance may be required to take 0 – 8 credits of Common Body of Knowledge courses. The MS Finance program is accredited by AACSB International.
