Degree Requirements

- 1. In addition to satisfying all other Graduate School requirements for a degree, students must complete a minimum of 30 units of course work including (1) a thesis or (2) a capstone experience consisting of at least one of the following: (a) a practicum, (b) a professional portfolio, or (c) a capstone seminar. Options vary depending on the emphasis. Those who choose practicum or portfolio may be required to complete specific courses associated with those options.
- All degree candidates are advised to complete EDFOUND 723/CIGENRL 723 and EDFOUND 780 within the first semester or as soon as possible after being admitted to the program.
- At least half of the graduate work in the degree program must be completed in courses numbered 700 or higher.
- 4. The professional core has been included in each emphasis.
