## Courses

### **COUNSED 450 INTRODUCTION TO COUNSELING 3 Units**

This is a survey course intended to introduce the student to the field of counseling and guidance. An overview of the purposes, procedures, and expected outcomes of counseling and guidance programs, the counselor's role and relationship to other functionaries will be dealt with.

### **COUNSED 490 WORKSHOP *Repeatable* 1-3 Units**

Variable topics. Group activity oriented presentations emphasizing "hands on" and participatory instructional techniques. Repeatable

### **COUNSED 491 TRAVEL STUDY *Repeatable* 1-3 Units**

Variable topics. Faculty-led courses abroad.

### **COUNSED 496 SPECIAL STUDIES *Repeatable* 1-3 Units**

Variable topics. Group activity. Not offered regularly in the curriculum but offered on topics selected on the basis of timeliness, need, and interest, and generally in the format of regularly scheduled Catalog offerings. Repeatable
